Crisp, juicy, sweet apple ranked as one of the highest quality apples. Over 3" Apple is richly coral-colored with a yellow background. Stores Well. Pollenizer recommended.   |
| Malus 'Granny Smith' S.D.                          | Apple Semi-Dwf. Granny Smith                | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Developed by the University of Minnesota in 1991, a cross of Macoun and Honeygold. Crisp, juicy, sweet apple ranked as one of the highest quality apples. Over 3" Apple is richly coral-colored with a yellow background. Stores Well. Pollenizer recommended.   |
| Malus Jonagold Apple SD                            | Jonagold Apple Semi Dwf Apple               | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Developed in 1953 in New York, a cross between the crisp Golden Delicious and the blush-crimson Jonathan. They form a large sweet fruit with a thin skin. Jonagold is triploid, with sterile pollen, and as such, requires a second type of apple for pollen and is incapable of pollinating other cultivars |
| Malus 'King' S.D.                                  | Apple Semi-Dwf. King                        | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Known simply as King, the large yellow-green apples with red stripes are excellent for eating fresh, for cooking and for making cider. They also keep well.  |
| Malus SD Honey Crisp Apple                         | Honey Crisp Apple Semi Dwarf                | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Developed by the University of Minnesota in 1991, a cross of Macoun and Honeygold. Crisp, juicy, sweet apple ranked as one of the highest quality apples. Over 3" Apple is richly coral-colored with a yellow background. Stores Well. Pollenizer recommended.   |
| Malus x domestica '4-Way Combination'              | 4 Way Combo Semi Dwf Apple                  | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Deciduous fruiting tree produces small pink single flowers in spring which turn white. Bears large, juicy fruit in late summer. Self Fruitful. Semi-Dwarf.   |
| Malus x domestica '6-Way Espalier'                 | 6 Way Espalier Semi Dwf Apple               | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Deciduous fruiting tree produces small pink single flowers in spring which turn white. 6 Varieties on one tree. Bears large, juicy fruit in late summer. Self Fruitful. Semi-Dwarf.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Everfresh (tm) Gala' SD         | Everfresh Gala Apple Semi Dwarf             | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Sprayless (tm) version of popular Apple. Mid Season harvest of bright scarlet fruit striped with yellow. Excellent quality, semi-sweet flavor. Keeps very well. Self fruitful.   |
| Malus x domestica 'Everfresh (tm) Red Delicious    | Everfresh Red Delicious Apple Semi Dwarf    | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Sprayless (tm) version of popular Apple. Mid Season harvest of medium red fruit with stripes. Apple is juicy, sweet and aromatic. Large upright tree. Cross-pollination necessary.   |
| Malus x domestica 'Everfresh (tm) Yellow Delicious | Everfresh Yellow Delicious Apple Semi Dwarf | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Sprayless (tm) version of popular Apple. Late Season harvest of medium to lg. yellow fruit with pink blush. Apple is crisp, firm and aromatic. Bears young. Cross-pollination necessary.   |
| Malus x domestica 'Fuji' SD                        | Fuji Apple Semi Dwarf                       | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Tapered form with red stripes. Medium to large fruit. Firm, very sweet. Excellent flavor, good keeper. Heavy bearer. Needs long season.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Gala' Dwf                       | Gala Dwarf Apple                            | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Mid Harvest Season-Bright scarlet striped with yellow, semi-sweet flavor. Excellent quality and keeping apple. Self-Fruitful.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Gala' SD                        | Gala Semi-Dwf Apple                         | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Mid Season harvest of bright scarlet fruit striped with yellow. Excellent quality, semi-sweet flavor. Keeps very well. Self fruitful.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Gravenstein' SD                 | Gravenstein Semi-Dwf Apple                  | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Large, vigorous growing tree producing large, orangish yellow fruit with red stripes. Thin skin. Crisp, juicy, fine grained, yellowish white flesh. Known for its fine flavor. Great for desserts, sauces and cider.   |
| Malus x domestica 'Pink Lady' SD                   | Pink Lady Semi-Dwf Apple                    | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Late Harvest oblong yellow fruit with a pink blush. Creamy white sweet-tart flesh. Long fruit storage life. Full Sun.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Red Delicious' SD               | Delicious Red Semi-Dwf Apple                | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Mid Season harvest of medium red fruit with stripes. Apple is juicy, sweet and aromatic. Large upright tree. Cross-pollination necessary.  |
| Malus x domestica 'Red McIntosh' SD                | Red McIntosh Semi Dwf Apple                 | Tree/Fruit | Apple     | Mid harvest season - Tree has vigorous growth habits and is very good in cool areas - Fruit is medium - red color is red - Apple is sweet and tender - Good for dessert - Requires pollinizer.   |
| Prunus 'Moorpark' SD                               | Wenatchee Moorpark Apricot SD               | Tree/Fruit | Apricot   | Proven Northwestern climates. Flavorful fruit used for fresh, canning and drying. Self Fruitful.   |
| Prunus '4 way Combo' Semi Dwarf                    | 4 way Combo Cherry Semi Dwarf               | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Strong, vigorous, upright tree. Heavy, annual producer. Produces large, shiny, sweet cherries. Good flavor. Excellent pollinator.  |
| Prunus avium 'Bing' SD                             | Bing Semi-Dwf Cherry                        | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Deciduous fruiting tree. Dark solid sweet flesh. Excellent for eating fresh. White, small, single flower. Blooms in spring. Pollinate with 'Black Tartarian'.  |
| Prunus avium 'Royal Anne' SD                       | Cherry Semi Dwf Royal Anne                  | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | A heavy-bearing, rapid-growing tree producing large, firm, light yellow fruit with a beautiful rose blush. Flesh is firm, juicy and sweet. Ideal for canning.  |
| Prunus avium 'Sweetheart'™                         | Sweetheart™ Cherry                          | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Van x Newstar. Self Fruitful. Large, bright red fruit with good flavor. Tree requires pruning to prevent size problems. Developed in Summerland, British Columbia.   |
| Prunus cerasus 'Lapins' SD                         | Cherry Semi-Dwf Lapins                      | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Early harvest large dark firm fruit. Excellent flavor and texture, Semi self fertile.  |
| Prunus cerasus 'Rainer' SD                         | Cherry Semi-Dwf Rainer                      | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Early harvest, yellow fruit with red blush. Firm sweet cherry. Use Bing, Sam or Van as a pollenizer.   |
| Prunus domestica 'Brooks' SD                       | Brooks Prune Semi Dwarf                     | Tree/Fruit | Prune     | Late harvest season producer of large oval purplish black fruit, sweet Oregon prune for drying and canning.  |
| Prunus domestica 'Italian' SD                      | Italian Semi-Dwf Prune                      | Tree/Fruit | Prune     | Heavy bearing tree with large oval purplish black fruit. Sweet tasting with some tartness. Good for cooking and fresh eating. Late harvest season.   |
| Prunus 'Frost' Semi Dwarf                          | Frost Semi Dwarf Peach                      | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Early to Mid harvest season-New and resistant to leaf curl-Good in cold regions-Much like Red Haven-Vigorous, productive peach.  |
| Prunus 'Golden Jubilee' SD                         | Golden Jubilee Peach Semi Dwf               | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Derived from Elberta, ripening three weeks earlier. Medium-sized, oblong, yellow freestone (red at pit). Skin one-third blushed with mottled red. Good for canning and fresh-eating.   |
| Prunus Peach Plum SD                               | Peach Plum Hybrid                           | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | "Peach-Plum Hybrid", an interspecific peach, includes peach and plum in its parentage.   |
| Prunus persica 'Early Elberta' SD                  | Early Elberta Semi Dwf Peach                | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Most popular of all peaches. This beautiful free-stone peach ripens during mid summer and is ideal for canning and eating because of its rich, yellow, juicy fruit. Grows to a height of 15 to 25 feet with an equal or greater spread.  |
| Prunus persica 'Flavortop'                         | Flavortop Nectarine                         | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Large beautiful blooms. Large, firm, yellow freestone of excellent quality. One of the very best!  |
| Prunus persica 'Red Haven' SD                      | Red Haven Peach Semi Dwarf                  | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | One of the largest, early ripening, high quality yellow free-stones. Red Haven has firm flesh and fine texture. Low, broad crowned fruit tree grows 15 to 25 feet with an equal spread. Plant alone or in groves. Red-skinned.   |
| Prunus persica 'Reliance' SD                       | Reliance Peach Semi Dwf                     | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Showy Late blooming. Very cold hardy/frost hardy. Sweet, flavorful yellow freestone. Harvest 2-3 weeks before Elberta.   |
| Prunus persica var. nucipersica SD                 | Goldmine Nectarine Semi Dwf                 | Tree/Fruit | Nectarine | Long-time favorite in California and Western Oregon. Small to medium-sized white-fleshed freestone. Aromatic, juicy and sweet.   |
| Prunus SD Bl Tartarian Cherry                      | Black Tartarian Cherry SD                   | Tree/Fruit | Cherry    | Early season medium sized Cherry nearly black. Requires pollinizer. Vigorous and Productive.   |
| Prunus SD Blenheim Apricot                         | Blenheim Apricot                            | Tree/Fruit | Apricot   | A good, all-purpose freestone, the Blenheim apricot is a medium-sized, sweet, aromatic fruit with very good flavor. Early blooming.  |
| Prunus 'Veteran' Semi Dwarf                        | Veteran Semi Dwarf Peach                    | Tree/Fruit | Peach     | Mid-Harvest season, highly productive peach. Medium size fruit is golden yellow with a red blush. Firm freestone fruit is juicy, fairly coarse. Good NW performer.   |
| Pyrus c. '20th Century/Nijisseiki                  | Asian Pear 20th Century                     | Tree/Fruit | Pear      | Rounded Asian Pear, mid harvest season. Sweet slightly tart, firm and juicy fruit. Pollenizers are Bartlett, Chojuro and Shinseikei. Medium size tree. Full Sun.   |
| Pyrus communis '4 Way Combination'                 | Pear 4-Way Combo Semi Dwf.                  | Tree/Fruit | Pear      | Beautiful, large richly flavored pears with golden-yellow color, blushed with red. 4 varieties on one tree. This young heavy bearer, ripens late August-September.   |
| Pyrus communis 'Bartlett' Dwf                      | Pear Bartlett Dwarf                         | Tree/Fruit | Pear      | Beautiful, large richly flavored pears with golden-yellow color, blushed with red. One of the best for canning. This young heavy bearer, ripens late August in the Midwest. Get best results by planting with another variety.   |
| Pyrus communis 'Comice' Dwf                        | Dwf. Pear Comice                            | Tree/Fruit | Pear      | The best Winter pear, requires cold storage to ripen. Yellow skin fruit with russet dots. Sweet, tender, and aromatic, large fruit. Large tree slow to bear.   |
| Pyrus communis 'Summercrisp' S.D.'                 | Semi-Dwf. Pear Summercrisp                  | Tree/Fruit | Pear      | Fireblight and disease resistant pear with sweet, crisp, green fruit with a red blush. Early to mid-season, very productive. Semi Dwarf. Full Sun.   |
