Actinidia arguta 'Issai'	Hardy Kiwi Vine	Produces small smooth skin fruit. Self fertile no pollinator needed. Attractive vine for arbor or trellis.
Ficus cardota 'Italian Black'	Italian Black Fig	A broadly spreading shrub or small tree growing to 25'. Produces two crops of jet black fruit with deep red pulp, an early crop on the old wood and a later crop on the new spring growth.
Fragaria a 'Sweet Ann' PP22472	Sweet Ann Everbearing Strawberry	Vigorous, highly productive, disease resistant, day length neutral variety. Large semi firm fruit with Old Fashioned strawberry flavor. Space 13"-15" apart.
Fragaria ananassa 'Albion'	Albion Everbearing Strawberry	Albion, an everbearing type, is a new variety with long, conical, symmetrical; firm fruit bursting with sweetness. Resists Verticillium wilt, Phytophthora crown rot and resistance to anthracnose crown rot.
Fragaria ananassa 'Hood'	Hood Strawberry-Sprg Bearing	A heavy producer of large, glossy deep red, exceptional sweet and fine flavored fruit. Vigorous June bearing plants. One of the best for fresh eating.
Fragaria Hula Berry®	Hula Berry® White Strawberry PP# 24,332	The Hula Berry® is a small white strawberry with red seeds that is full of flavor, in fact many say it taste like a Pineapple! The Hula Berry® is an improved Pineberry, which is a very old variety dating back to the 18th century. Unlike red strawberries, white strawberries cannot pollinate themselves. So the secret to success in growing the Hula Berry® is the included pollinator variety, Sonata. This is a larger, red fruiting variety that is very tasty as well. Available only in baskets late spring.
Lycium b. 'Crimson Star'	Crimson Star Goji Berry	Plant is full sun with a southern exposure. Purple flowers in early summer yield bright red berries August to October. Harvest by shaking the vine. Berries are the size of a raisin and may be eaten fresh or dried.
Lycium b. 'Phoenix Tears'	Phoenix Tears Goji Berry	Plant is full sun with a southern exposure. Purple flowers in early summer yield bright red berries August to October. Harvest by shaking the vine. Berries are the size of a raisin and may be eaten fresh or dried.
Rubus f. 'Sweetie Pie'	Sweetie Pie Blackberry	New disease resistant thornless trailing blackberry from the USDA. Medium size, glossy black berries with high sugar content and excellent flavor.
Rubus idaeus Amity	Amity Raspberry (Everbearing)	Everbearing variety with large dark red berries and classic raspberry flavor. Good for freezing and canning. Bears two crops on canes one in fall and one following spring.
Rubus idaeus 'Meeker'	Meeker Raspberry	Large dark red fruit with high sugar content and excellent flavor. Very productive with a long harvest season. Ripens midseason. Developed at Washington State University.
Rubus idaeus 'NR7' P.P.#22,141	Raspberry Shortcake™ Dwf. Ras	Dwarf, thornless red raspberry, rounded growth habit and thrives in a large patio pot or in the landscape. Does not require staking. Self fertile, yielding large, nutritious, super sweet berries in mid-summer. Deciduous.
Rubus idaeus 'Willamette'	Willamette Raspberry	An excellent raspberry for eating fresh, canning, or freezing. Dark red, firm berries that maintain color and shape. Very vigorous and productive. Ripens early and is disease resistant. Originated in Oregon.
Rubus u. Black Satin Thornless	Black Satin Thornless Blackber	Produces large glossy blackberries in July. Sweet flavor. Thornless vines with heavy yields. Berries are great for jams and fresh eating. Does best in zones 5-9.
Rubus u. 'Triple Crown'	Triple Crown Thornless Blackbe	This new thornless blackberry is named for its three crowning attributes flavor, productivity, and vigor. Thornless vines that yield large amounts of fruit. Produces larger berries than other thornless varieties.
Rubus ursinus 'Boysen'	Boysenberry Blackberry	Very large berries, among the largest. Juicy, aromatic berries are used for juice, canning, freezing, jellies, and eating fresh. Fruit ripens around July 1. Vigorous vines perform best in full sun. Deciduous.
Rubus ursinus 'Marion'	Marionberry Blackberry	Excellent flavored large bright black berries ripen in early August. Smaller seeded than Boyson berries and possibly hardier. Delicious fresh and for jams, desserts, and cooking. Vigorous strong growing plant. Deciduous. Full Sun.
Rubus x 'APF-236T' P.P.A.F.	Baby Cakes™ Dwf Blackberry	A dwarf thornless blackberry, great for container growing. Sweet large berries in mid summer. May fruit a second time in fall in cooler climates.
Vaccinium c. 'Blueberry Glaze™	BrazilBerries®Blueberry Glaze™	Small grower with dark gloosy green leaves. White and pink spring flowers with small dark almost black berries in summer. Intense flavor like wild blueberries. Great for patio pots.
Vaccinium c. 'Bluecrop'	Bluecrop Blueberry	Mid-season harvest. Considered the best all-around variety for consistently heavy yields of high-quality fruit. The berry is larger than average, light blue, and extremely flavorful. The upright open bush grows to 4-6 feet.
Vaccinium c. Blueray	Blueray Blueberry	Blue foliage. Pink-blushed flowers produce a large crop of large, sweet, juicy berries on a compact, mounded shrub. Perfect for massing in the landscape or featuring in large tubs.

Vaccinium c. 'Chandler'	Chandler Blueberry	'Chandler' is a highbush blueberry cultivar which typically grows 5-6' tall and features perhaps the largest blueberries produced by any highbush cultivar available.
Vaccinium c. 'Darrow'	Darrow Blueberry	Big and popular blueberries. vigorous, attractive bush features pink-kissed flowers in spring and vibrant scarlet leaves in fall. Ripens in August.
Vaccinium c. 'Duke'	Duke Blueberry	A reliable, consistent, heavy producing variety that blooms late but ripens early, protecting blossoms from late frosts.
Vaccinium c. 'Elliott'	Elliott Blueberry	Large crops of good size very late season, fruit often into September. Tangy fruit needs to fully ripen on bush. Red orange fall foliage.
Vaccinium c. Jelly Bean™	BrazelBerries® Jelly Bean™	Cold-hardy that produces bumper crops of large, delicious berries in mid-summer, sweet flavor like homemade blueberry jelly. Exceptional compact form makes a great low hedge or feature plant for patio containers.
Vaccinium c. Peach Sorbet™	BrazelBerries® Peach Sorbet™	Compact blueberry, white, bell-shaped flowers in spring give way to an abundant crop of delicious, sweet blueberries. Glossy leaves range in color from peachy pink to orange to emerald green. Evergreen in most climates. An outstanding choice for the landscape or patio.
Vaccinium c. 'Pink Icing'™	BrazelBerries® Pink Icing™	Beautiful spring and fall foliage. New growth in spring varying shades of pink. Robust flavored berries. Excellent for use in patio pots or the landscape.
Vaccinium c. Spartan	Spartan Blueberry	Tasty fruit often larger than a quarter in size with a tangy sweet flavor. Ripens mid-July. Large, glossy-green foliage becomes orange and yellow in fall. Small white, bell-shaped flowers precede the berries. Deciduous.
Vaccinium c. x 'Northsky'	Northsky Blueberry	Great for container gardening. Fresh wild blueberry flavor berries mid season. Good landscape plant, red, burgundy fall foliage.
Vaccinium c. x 'Polaris'	Polaris Blueberry	An early season companion to Chippewa. Delicate sweet medium sized fruit. Fresh eating. Red fall foliage.
Vaccinium 'Pink Lemonade'	Pink Lemonade Blueberry	Developed by the USDA, pretty and tasty. Pink, firm, glossy, medium-sized berries, with a mild flavor, sweet and flowery. It ripens from mid-late to late season. Good landscape plant.
Vitis labrusca 'Vanessa'	Vanessa Grape	Deep red medium size oval shaped seedless grapes. Early ripener. The flavor is mild and fruity, and berry texture is firm. The fruit quality is among the best of the red seedless types.
Vitis v. 'Flame Seedless'	Flame Seedless	Early ripening red seedless grape. Americas most popular supermarket grape. Mild sweet flavor. Good vigor and productivity.
Vitis v. 'Fresno Seedless'	Fresno Seedless	The most popular of all seedless grapes, this white grape is a sibling of Flame Seedless. A small to medium size berry with a yellow skin. Ripens early.
Vitis v. 'Jupiter'	Jupiter Grape	Red-blue berries are large, oval in medium size bunches. Early to Mid Season. Very productive and winter hardy. University of Arkansas introduction.
Vitis v. 'Neptune'	Neptune Grape	Large very showy clusters of medium yellow green seedless berries ripen mid season. Firm berries with thick skin, resistant to cracking. Cold hardy.
Vitis v. 'Suffolk Red'	Suffolk Red Grape	Suffolk Red produces medium to large clusters of mild-flavored seedless red berries that ripen in September, two weeks before Concord.
