

#### **BLUEBERRY GUIDE**

## **Planting**

They prefer a location with acidic soil with a pH around 4.5-5.5, full sun at least 6-8 hours a day and well-drained soil. Dig a hole around 2-3 times the size of the root ball. Space bushes about 2 ft apart and larger varieties 4-5 ft apart.

## **Fertilizing**

Fertilize typically about twice a year, the first in early spring before new growth starts and second around late spring/early summer. Use a fertilizer for acid-loving plants.

Follow package instructions to determine dosage.

# **Pruning**

The best time to prune is early spring, around January to early March, when the plant is dormant. Pruning is not often needed for the first 1-2 years. Blueberries often take around 2-3 years to begin producing fruit.

#### **Pollination**

Most blueberries are self-fertile however, some varieties require another blueberry plant. There is evidence that some blueberry plants will have a higher yield if cross-pollinated with another variety.
