Tomatoes

Colors can range from red, to yellow, orange, green, pink, purple, even to black. With a variety of sizes and flavors as well, check out the varieties and information below to choose the varieties that fit your needs. Determinate tomatoes grow to a certain size and produce all their fruit at one time.

Indeterminate tomatoes will continue to grow and produce fruit for the entire growing season.

Variety	Description
Amish Paste	Highly productive heirloom tomato, prized for making thick, rich sauces and pastes. Indeterminate: 80-85 days
Anna Russian	Dark pink to red, heart-shaped tomato with 12-16oz fruit. Indeterminate: 65-75 days
Beaverlodge Slicer	Cold-tolerant, early maturing, medium red slicer. Determinate: 55 days
Beefsteak	Flavorful, round, juicy and an excellent slicer with 12-20oz fruit. Indeterminate: 80 days

Better Boy	Popular and high-yielding hybrid slicer, disease resistant. Large meaty, bright red fruit with a classic flavor. Requires staking for its 6-8ft, vigorous vines. Indeterminate: 72 days
Big Beef	Improved beefsteak hybrid, strong disease resistance. Produces large, globe-shaped red fruit with a classic, rich, and tangy flavor. Indeterminate: 73 days
Big Beef Plus	Enhanced Big Beef F1 hybrid with added resistance. Indeterminate: 70-73 days
Black Angel	Dark brown-red hybrid F1 slicer, rich flavor. High-yielding, and compact. Determinate: 65 days
Black Krim	Gorgeous tomato with a unique color that is dark reddish, purple to black. They have a rich and sweet flavor. Indeterminate: 80 days
Black Sea Man	Olive green brownish tomato inside and out with 8-14oz fruit. They have a rich flavor and are highly productive. Determinate: 75 days.
Bloody Butcher	Fruit is deep red inside and out, with a great tomato flavor. These tomatoes grow in clusters of 4oz. Indeterminate: 55 days.
Brandywine	Unique taste of fruity, sweet and spicy. It's one of the largest and most popular heirloom tomatoes. Can weigh up to 24oz. Indeterminate: 78-90 days

Bush Goliath	Large, red tomato packed with flavor. Plant grows 2-4ft. Determinate: 65-68 days
Candyland Red	Dark red, currant-sized sweet fruit. Tidy habit with fruit clustered on the outside for easy harvesting. Indeterminate: 55 days
Carmello	Bright red popular French tomato with a sweet flavor and 8-12oz fruit. Highly productive and disease resistant. Indeterminate 65-70 days.
Celebrity	Dependable, disease-resistant hybrid. Produces heavy yields of large 7-12 oz, globe-shaped red fruit. Determinate: 70 days
Celebrity Plus	Highly disease-resistant and high-yielding slicer F1 hybrid. Determinate: 70 days
Cherokee Carbon	Hybrid with Cherokee flavor and improved vigor. Dusky purple-burgundy beefsteak with a rich, complex, and slightly smoky flavor. Indeterminate: 75 days
Cherokee Purple	Brown, green, and purple 8-12oz fruit with a flavor that is sweet, acidic, and a bit of smokiness. Indeterminate: 72-80 days
Chocolate Cherry	This tomato has rich mahogany-purple color and a rich, sweet flavor. Expect high yields on this strong, fast-growing plant. Indeterminate: 70 days

Cosmonaut Volkov	Early-maturing, red slicing heirloom tomato from Ukraine with a full complex flavor and fruit 8-12oz. Known for heavy yields of large, slightly flattened fruits that offer a sweet, tangy, and rich, full-bodied flavor. Thrives in cool conditions. Indeterminate: 65 days
Damsel	Disease-resistant pink, meaty beefsteak-style slicer F1 hybrid with exceptional heirloom-like flavor. Indeterminate: 75 days
Dona	Disease-resistant and heavy-yielding, renown for balanced sweet/acid flavor. Deep-red fruits that are slightly flattened, meaty, and almost seedless. Ideal for salads, sandwiches, and slicing. Indeterminate: 65 days
Early Girl	Red Fruit and early producing until frost with 4-6 oz fruit. Indeterminate: 60-65 days
Early Girl Plus	Improved for enhanced disease resistance and high yields. Indeterminate: 54 days
Gill's All-Purpose	Bred in Oregon. Reliable, high-yielding, early slicing/sauce variety. Produces deep-red globe-shaped fruits with a rich, classic flavor. Determinate: 80 days.
Green Zebra	Green striped tart-sweet fruit. Indeterminate: 75 days.
Indigo Rose	Developed by Oregon State University. Dark purple, almost black with red interior, high-antioxidant cherry tomato with a savory "plummy" flavor. Indeterminate: 80 days

Jaune Flamme	Highly productive, small orange salad tomato, fruity. Indeterminate: 70 days.
Jungle Red	High-yielding, red F1 hybrid grape tomato. Ideal for both containers and field growing. Semi-determinate: 70 days
La Roma III	Improved Roma paste type. High-yielding and disease-resistant. Determinate: 75 days
Matt's Wild Cherry	Tiny with a full flavor that is sweet and tangy. Plant grows rapidly. Indeterminate: 60-65 day
Midnight Roma	Dark, nutrient-rich paste tomato developed by Oregon State University. Savory-sweet flavor. Indeterminate: 80 days
Moskvitch	Deep red color with 4-6 oz fruits that have a rich flavor. Produces early and best eaten fresh or processed. Indeterminate. Takes up to 60 days to mature.
Oregon Cherry	Early, highly productive, open-pollinated red cherry variety developed by Oregon State University. Thin skin and sweet. Determinate: 60 days
Oregon Spring	This early season variety was developed by Oregon State University and has a thin skin and sweet flavor. Determinate: 58-62 days

Paisano	Red fruit great for making soups and ketchup. It has a fresh taste. Determinate: 72-75 days
Paul Robeson	Round and slightly flattened, deep, brick-red color with green shoulders. Can grow to be 3-4in in diameter. Indeterminate 72-76 days.
Rainbow Blend	Mixed heirloom color blend. Indeterminate: 75-85 days
Red Racer	Award-winning cocktail tomato, producing deep red fruits in large, early-season clusters. Sweet-yet-tart. Disease-resistant and compact. Determinate: 57 days
Red Velvet	Compact, micro-dwarf tomato growing only 6-12in tall. Ideal for pots, windowsills, and small patios. Produces high yields of sweet, bright red cherry tomatoes. Determinate: 70-85 days
Roma	One of the most popular heirloom tomatoes for cooking and canning and saucing. Determinate: 72-75 days
Roma Cherry	Small Roma-style paste fruit. Indeterminate: 75 days
San Marzano	Red-pink tomato with the shape of a plum. Is known for its flavor and quality as a canning tomato. Indeterminate: 80 days.
Siam	Compact hybrid cherry tomato designed for small-spaces. Grows 7-12in tall. Determinate: 70 days

Siletz	Early-maturing, reliable, large deep-red slicing tomato developed by Oregon State University. Compact at 3-4ft. Determinate: 57-75 days
Siletz Extra Early	Large, deep-red slicing tomatoes developed by Oregon State University suited for cool climates and short-season gardening. Determinate: 52-65 days
Striped German	This is a beautiful yellow tomato with a pinkish striped coloring exterior and marbled bicolored interior, and sweet and juicy taste. Fruit can grow up to 3lbs in size! Indeterminate: 85 days
Stupice	This tomato is known for its earliness, and can also tolerate the cold, with superior flavor and 2-4oz fruit. Indeterminate: 55-62 days.
Sungold	This orange cherry tomato hybrid F1 has a sweet-tart flavor. Indeterminate: 60-65 days
Sun Sugar	This golden-yellow tomato has a sugary and sweet flavor. Indeterminate: 63 days
Sunrise Bumble Bee	Yellow and red colored fruits with a sweet and tangy flavor. Indeterminate: 70-75 days
Sweet 100/Super Sweet 100	Thin skinned cherry tomatoes with a sweet and sugary flavor. Highly productive. Indeterminate: 60-70 days

Sweet Million	Very bright red and a sweet tomato. Vigorous and popular for their high yield and disease and crack resistance. Indeterminate: 65 days
Sweet Pea	Small cherry tomato known for their intense, rich, and sugary flavor with a hint of wine. Ideal for snacking and salads. Vigorous and adaptable for hanging baskets. Indeterminate: 65 days
Tidy Treats	Compact patio cherry tomato. Indeterminate in production but compact like a determinate: 70 days
Tumbling Tom Red & Yellow Cherry	Cascading tomatoes with vines that can trail up to 2ft. These tomatoes are deliciously sweet. Determinate: 60-70 days
Washington Cherry	Cold-adapted, compact, larger than typical cherry tomato from Washington State University. Determinate: 65 days
Willamette	PNW reliable, early-season, heirloom slicer from Oregon State University. Determinate: 70 days
WonderStar™ Pink	Pink hybrid F1 beefsteak. Compact plant great for small-spaces and containers. Indeterminate: 75 days
Yellow Pear	Yellow, pear-shaped tomatoes with a mild sweet and tangy flavor and can take up to 70-75 days to mature. Indeterminate.



Mighty 'Mato

Mighty 'Mato are non-GMO tomatoes hand-grafted onto special rootstock for enhanced vigor and productivity. Check out the grafted varieties we are carrying this year, including Ketchup 'N' Fries, which grafts a cherry tomato onto a potato plant.

Ketchup 'N' Fries		A grafted plant featuring a cherry tomato plant on top and a potato plant on bottom, producing both tomatoes and potatoes simultaneously. This plant yields hundreds of cherry tomatoes and several pounds of potatoes in one season.
